As always, your default interrogative is “what”, but give your answer first to be sure

1:6 Observing what were both of them upright in the sight of God? (Observing) all the Lord’s commandments and regulations (blamelessly)

The interrogative will not always be the 2<sup>nd</sup> word, but it will be in the first 3

1:30 Do not what (Mary)? (Do not) Be afraid
